

## Crochet Bell Pattern



DK and a 3.5/E hook

Scissors and a yarn needle

Leave at least a 3 inch for the hanging loop. Magic ring

1. Ch 3 (counts as 1<sup>st</sup> stitch) dc, ch 1 \*2 dc, ch 1\* repeat from \* to \* until you have 6 groups of 2 dc's and ch 1. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 3
2. Slip stitch into next dc and ch 1 space (ch 3, dc, ch 1, 2 dc) all into the ch 1 space \*2 dc, ch 1, 2dc into the next ch 1 space\* repeat from \* to \* around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 3
3. Repeat round 2
4. Repeat round 2
5. Repeat round 2
6. Slip stitch into next dc and ch 1 space. Ch 3, 7 dc into the same ch 1 space, sc into the next SPACE \*8 dc into ch 1 space, sc into the next SPACE\* around. You will end on a sc. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 3  
Finish off and sew in end

### Top loop

Secure end of tail on the inside of the magic ring leaving the excess on the outside for the hanging loop – see video for more detail at the 15 minute mark
